As we are all experiencing, the upward cost pressures and overall volatility of supply continues to affect virtually all the component and transit costs of our products. As a result, many of our suppliers continue to pass along fuel surcharges due to the rising cost of oil and the weakening dollar.

Below is MACtac's current sliding scale from which fuel surcharges will be determined. These charges are based on the national monthly average diesel price as published by the Department of Energy (DOE). http://tonto.eia.doe.gov/dnav/pet/pet_pri_gnd_a_epd2d_pte_cpgal_m.htm

Fuel surcharge adjustments will be made on the last business day of the month based on the national average for diesel from the previous month according to the DOE.
