The adhesive is protected by a 72# Poly-Coated Kraft release liner; the "L" version has a 1.2 mil PET process liner if dual liner handling is preferred. This product is designed for applications that require a combination high initial tack and cohesive strength with exceptionally smooth adhesive appearance.


